## INTERMEDIATE MEASURES

The Joint Monitoring Committee (JMC) of the South-East Finland – Russia CBC 2014–2020 Programme has approved the project for funding in its meeting of 18/12/2018, with the final quality score of 168,34 out of maximum of 200,00.

## CONTENT OF THE PROJECT AND TERMS OF FUNDING

The amount of funding for the project is 681 973,00 euros, at the most, covering 80% of the eligible costs of the project. The funding granted for the project, the eligible actions, and other terms related to the project funding shall be specified in a separate grant contract, which shall be concluded between the lead partner of the project and the Managing Authority of the Programme.

#### APPEAL

A decision made by the Regional Council may be appealed against as prescribed in the Local Government Act (410/2015) on claims for a revised decision and submitting an appeal against the decision of a municipal authority.
