## Letter of Commitment

## Participation in the Horizon 2020 project "From plans to practice – piloting valorization of urban bioresources [ValUrBio]"

City of Helsinki commits to participate in the Horizon 2020 project "From plans to practice – piloting valorization of urban bioresources [ValUrBio]" (topic CE-FNR-17-2020), coordinated by the Natural Resources Institute Finland, if the project is funded by the European Commission. City of Helsinki is capital of Finland having population of 650 000 inhabitants.
